
Ticket Entry Points

How to get to Aviva Stadium



Travelling to
Aviva Stadium by
public transport
is simple

Aviva Stadium is well served by public transport with Bus, DART, LUAS and Rail bringing you within a short picturesque walk of the stadium. There are no parking facilities at Aviva Stadium on large event days, so it makes sense to arrange your journey to the stadium by public transport to ensure that you arrive stress-free and on time, leaving you nothing else to do but enjoy your visit. A colour coded ticketing system and special event day signs are used to help direct you towards your correct entrance to Aviva Stadium, please take note of your entrance when planning your journey.

Dublin Bus is currently in the process of redesigning their bus network to provide customers with a more understandable, direct and frequent services.
