## Soccer Target Practice

You will need:

- Two 2/3 litre milk containers filled with water (Take off the label)
- A football
- Two people or two teams

How to play:

- Place milk container number one at one end of the garden and milk container number two about 4/5 metres away
- Person one stands behind milk carton number one and person two stands behind milk carton number two
- Person one kicks the ball and tries to knock over person two's milk container. At the same time person two is standing a metre away from their milk container ready to stand their milk container up if it gets knocked over
- Person two then takes their turn to kick the ball and try knock over person one's milk container
- The winner of the game is the person who empties the other person's milk container first. But watch out. The quicker you get to the falling milk container the wetter you'll get!!
- If more than two people are playing you can make two teams. The more the merrier!!



## Target Throwing

You will need:

- Chalk
- A different colour pair of rolled-up socks for each player
- A driveway or path

How to play:

- On a driveway or safe path, draw the targets as shown in the picture below
- Stand away from the target and try to throw the rolled-up socks onto the target
- The person who hits the highest target wins each round



## Giant garden sock matching game

You will need:

- Ten different pairs of matching socks (different sizes and colours will make it more fun)
- A stopwatch
- A laundry basket/bucket

How to play:

- Place the socks in view all around the garden and choose who is player one, two etc
- Put the laundry basket/bucket somewhere in the garden
- Get the stopwatch ready so you can time each player
- The aim of the game is to match the socks and put them in the laundry basket in the quickest time
- However, if you pick up a sock and can't find the match, you must place that sock back down and try for another pair
- The winner is the person who gets all the matching pairs of socks in the basket in the quickest time
