Family Members, Carers and Supporters Advisory Network

St Patrick's Mental Health Services (SPMHS) invites family members, carers and supporters of our current or former service users to join our Family Members, Carers and Supporters (FCS) Advisory Network.

What is the FCS Advisory Network?

The FCS Advisory Network was established to enable engagement and consultation with family members, carers and supporters of service users of SPMHS. The views and perspectives of family members, carers and supporters is central to our service user engagement strategy and the implementation of our current five-year strategic plan, *The Future in Mind 2023 - 2027.*

What does joining the FCS Advisory Network involve?

FCS Advisory Network members are kept informed about focus groups and consultation forums which they can attend. These groups provide the opportunity for SPMHS to present ideas to the members of the network about changes being considered, and for members to share their ideas and opinions to make sure that the views of those who support our service users are heard and included. Members will also be invited to join working groups and steering committees to help develop new projects.

Many of our projects will be 'business sensitive' - this means we need to keep information about the project confidential, and you may be asked to sign a confidentiality agreement about a project you are involved with.

How do I join?

To join the FSC Advisory Network, simply complete the registration form on the back of this leaflet. You can post this form to the Service User Engagement Lead, St Patrick's University Hospital, James' Street, Dublin 8, or visit **stpatricks.ie/get-involved** where you can also complete this form online.

What happens when I join?

Once you have registered, you will be added to the FSC Advisory Network mailing list where you will receive regular updates by email about opportunities to take part in various groups or projects. You will also be kept informed about events and initiatives that may be of interest to you. There is no obligation to take part in the different groups and projects and you can opt out of the network and mailing list at any time.

I'm a service user, can I join the FCS Advisory Network?
